UPA APPLAUDS EPA'S WITHDRAWAL OF PROPOSED IN SITU RECOVERY RULE

The Uranium Producers of America (UPA) applauds the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) for withdrawing its unnecessary proposed rule regarding groundwater monitoring for in situ uranium recovery (ISR). We are pleased the EPA agrees with the concerns expressed by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) – the chief nuclear regulator in the U.S. – that this rule exceeded the EPA's authority and would impose burdensome requirements without corresponding environmental benefit.
